

USA HOCKEY ATLANTIC DISTRICT PLAYER DEVELOPMENT

2017 Details For 12U - 2005's

PROGRAM OVERVIEW: This program is a prerequisite to being chosen for the Quebec teams. For the 12's who are interested in going to the Quebec Pee Wee International tournament, we will host an OPEN TRYOUT at the Flyers Skate Zone, Voorhees, NJ. From the open tryout, we will select 68-80 players to then participate at a Tryout Festival. Following the tryout festival, we will then select the fifty-four players who will make-up the Lehigh Valley Phantoms, NJ Devils & Philadelphia Flyers Quebec Teams.



Those goalies who are invited from the open tryout will also attend a District Goalie overnight Camp in June prior to the tryout festival.

The 54 players (including goalies) chosen to attend Quebec will then be invited to a overnight weekend camp at the Flyers Skate Zone, Voorhees, NJ.



OPEN TRYOUTS:

As per above, all 2005 players will need to tryout the weekend of June 3-4, 2017. Below is the tryout schedule. Pre-registrations are being taken online that will include a minimum of two tryouts.



Cuts can be made after the second tryout. If invited back, the third tryout cost is already included in the original fee. If pre-registered and paid online, the cost of the tryout will be \$80 inclusive. All walk-ons who do not pre-register or who registered and did not pay, will be charged \$100 payable at the door either by

credit card or cash. Once pre-registered, no refunds will be issued. Pre-registration will close on May 25, 2017. All players will receive a tryout jersey when they arrive to wear during the tryout and for players to keep afterwards.

Due to the amount of players who attend the tryouts, the easiest way of doing this is to break the players down by their telephone area codes. All players who have an area code of 215, 267, 484, 610, 835, 717, 570, 609, 856 and 302 will attend the South tryout times. Players who reside in New Jersey with all other area codes (other than 609 and 856) and players who reside in New York but are registered with an Atlantic District program, will use the North tryout times.

On Saturday morning, at your first tryout session, we will let you know at registration what time/team you have been placed onto for the afternoon session so that you know when to return in the afternoon. After the goalie session on Saturday at 8:30 AM, all goalies will be told if they are to go on the ice with North F, North D, South F, South D.

On Saturday night, following the tryouts, you will receive an email from hocky@erols.com letting you know if you have been cut or have been chosen to return for the Sunday tryout.

For the tryouts on Sunday, remaining players from Saturday's tryouts will be told what group they will be placed into for Sunday's tryouts so you know what time to return on Sunday. Again, this will be done by email on Saturday night. The top goalies, forwards and defensemen chosen from the tryout festival may be placed on either of the three teams regardless of the area they live in. Keep in mind - we are looking to choose the top players in the District and then place them on teams.

AFTER OPEN TRYOUTS:

Following the OPEN TRYOUT all players will be notified by the end of business, Wednesday, June 7, via email if they are chosen to attend the tryout festival. Players chosen will then receive a second email -FROM INFO@USAHOCKEY- with a link to register for the tryout festival. The cost for the tryout festival is \$220.00

TRYOUT FESTIVAL:

The festival will be held the weekend of July 22-23, 2017 at the Flyers Skate Zone in Voorhees, NJ. All registrations must be done online prior to the festival using the registration link received by email from Info@USAHockey. The registration fee includes all of the ice time plus a tryout jersey and socks for the players to wear during the tryout festival and to keep afterwards. No walk-ons will be permitted. This is not an open tryout. You need to attend the open tryout in order to be invited to the tryout festival.

AFTER THE TRYOUT FESTIVAL:

Following the tryout festival, all players will be notified via email by the end of business Wednesday, July 26, following the festival if they are chosen to attend the Quebec Tournament. Players chosen to advance will then receive a second email -FROM USA HOCKEY- with a link to register for the Quebec Tournament as well as the camp that all players are required to attend. The fee for the camp does not include the fee to attend the Quebec Tournament. The Quebec team fee will be \$800 each. This will be paid separately from the camp.

RECAP OF THE TRYOUT SCHEDULE:

- Open Tryout: June 3-4, 2017 (\$80.00 if pre-registered; \$100 if paid at door)
- District Goalie Camp: June 17-18, 2017 (\$220.00)
- Tryout Festival: July 22-23, 2017 (\$220.00)
- Development Camp: August 19-20, 2017 (\$395.00)

CAMP INFORMATION:

All of our camps will be held at the Flyers Skate Zone in Voorhees, NJ. Lodging for the camps will be held across the street from the rink at the Springhill Suites or at the Wyngate hotel. Players will room with a partner. Staff will be on site at all times. Players will walk back and forth from the rink to the hotels. The players must stay overnight at the camp with the other players and staff.

Reservations at the two hotels have already been made by the Atlantic District. The players will stay as a group. Parents do not make reservations for the players. The hotel is included in the camp fee.

The camp fee of \$395 includes: hotel, food, ice time, home and away jerseys/socks, golf shirt, t-shirt, shorts, Player Development equipment bag

While breakfast will be served at the hotel, all lunches and dinners will be eaten at Passariello's restaurant on the same side of the street as the rink. Players will be permitted to order what they would like with recommendations from the staff. Players will walk to the restaurant for lunch and dinner.

Our camp will be held **August 19-20, 2017**. **Goalies are also invited to a separate goalie camp that will be held June 17-18.**

All players and goalies will arrive at 9:00 AM on **August 19** at the Flyers Skate Zone rink. Players will need to bring their clothes, equipment and toiletries with them to the rink to be transported at a later time to the hotel. Players will depart on August 20 around 6:00 PM from the rink. Parents will drop off the players and pick them back up. Parents are welcome to watch the camp, but are not permitted to have interaction with the players.

All goalies only will arrive at 9:00 AM on **June 17** at the Flyers Skate Zone rink. Goalies will need to bring their clothes, equipment and toiletries with them to the rink to be transported at a later time to the hotel. Goalies will depart on June 18 around 6:00 PM from the rink. Parents will drop off the goalies and pick them back up. Parents are welcome to watch the camp, but are not permitted to have interaction with the players. Cost of this camp is \$220, which does not include the camp on July 20.

Following the August camp, all players and goalies will then start to follow their team schedule for the Quebec team in which they have been assigned. Please go to our website, www.atlantic-district.org, and go to the player development page. Please go to the 2005 overview at the bottom of the page showing a sample itinerary of our last year's trip and how it works! The top goalies, forwards and defensemen chosen may be placed on any of the three teams regardless of the area they live in. Keep in mind - we are looking to choose the top players in the District and then place them on teams!

The team registration fee of \$800 to be on a Quebec team includes: Ice time as sampled on overview, team home and away jerseys/socks, team mock turtlenecks, team jackets, team travel bags, team hats, travel by bus for both player and 1 parent, billet party, team pins, team picture, tournament registration, etc.
