2017 Details For 13U - 2004's

PROGRAM OVERVIEW: ALL RETURNING PLAYERS who went to Quebec with the Devils, Flyers or Phantoms District teams will be invited to the Development Camps! There is NO TRYOUT FESTIVAL! New 2004's (who did not go to Quebec with a District Team) will need to attend the OPEN TRYOUT on April 22 & 23. Returners, and those selected from the open, will participate in a camp/Jamboree at Voorhees in July. Our goal is to invite a maximum of 80 players to our Development camps which will include, seminars, video sessions, off ice training, position specific training, cross-ice small games, and competition.

OPEN TRYOUTS:

As per above, all new players who have not been part of our program will need to tryout the weekend of April 22 & 23. Below is the schedule for the tryout that will be held at the Flyers Skate Zone, Voorhees, NJ. Pre-registrations are being taken online that will include a minimum of two tryouts. Cuts can be made after the second tryout. If invited back, the third tryout cost is already included in the original fee. If pre-registered, the cost of the tryout will be \$80 inclusive. All walk-ons who do not pre-register, will be charged \$100 payable at the door either by credit card or cash. Once pre-registered, no refunds will be issued. Pre-registration will close on March 30. All players will receive a tryout jersey when they arrive to wear during the tryout and for players to keep afterwards. Online registrations are being taken at:

CAMP INFORMATION:

All of our camps will be held at the Flyers Skate Zone in Voorhees, NJ. Lodging for the camps will be held across the street from the rink at the Springhill Suites or at the Wyngate hotel. Players will room with a partner. Staff will be on site at all times. Players will walk back and forth from the rink to the hotels. The players must stay overnight at the camp with the other players and staff.

While breakfast will be served at the hotel, all lunches and dinners will be eaten at Passariello's restaurant on the same side of the street as the rink. Players will be permitted to order what they would like with recommendations from the staff. Players will walk to the restaurant for lunch and dinner.

Our camp will be held **July 20-21** being both a camp with a jamboree. **Goalies are also invited to a separate goalie camp that will be held June 17-18.**

All players will arrive at 9:00 AM on **July 20** at the Flyers Skate Zone rink. Players will need to bring their clothes, equipment and toiletries with them to the rink to be transported at a later time to the hotel. Players will depart on July 21 around 6:00 PM from the rink. Parents will drop off the players and pick them back up. Parents are welcome to watch the camp, but are not permitted to have interaction with the players.

All goalies will arrive at 9:00 AM on **June 17** at the Flyers Skate Zone rink.
